Weeks 1 - 11	Read aloud/view a selection of texts – YouTube clips, picture story books, magazines, comics etc. Phonics: Sounding out words (decoding) Comprehension/Understanding: Retelling the story after it's finished Identifying the start, middle, end Talking about character feelings Answering the following questions about the book: Do you think this is a good title? Why/why not? What is the message of the text? (Do they want us to have better morals etc) Why did the author write this? (for enjoyment or to educate etc)	Write the sounds that you can hear in the word you're writing, for example: for the word swimming a student might write 'simi' as they know those sounds. Tick each individual sound they get that is in the word to acknowledge they are right, there is no need to correct this further. Accurately spelling familiar, frequently used words like a, all, be, come, for, I, is, of, some, the, to, was, you. Accurately placing full stops at the end of sentences and capital letters for the start of sentences and names. Write simple sentences or short stories and draw pictures to match.	Sharing feelings and opinions with family members. Discussing likes and dislikes with family members. Engaging in discussions during play based activities with family members.
