STUDENT LED INTERVIEWS - JULY 19TH - 1PM - 6PM

Dear Families,

We will be shifting from our previous format of Parent Teacher Interviews to Student Led Interviews. The shift is aimed at enhancing greater opportunities for student voice and agency. The skills that students develop in readiness for these interviews are extremely valuable and aligns with our aim of creating happy and confident learners that are:

- active participants in their learning
- able to articulate their strengths and areas for improvement
- able to reflect deeply on what and how they best learn
- able share their successes and challenges at school

As these will be Student Led Interviews, students must attend the interviews with their parents/guardians. Students will be leading these learning conversations with the support of their teacher.

The Student Led Interviews are strictly 10 minutes and will be held in your child's classroom. If you need more time with a particular teacher, arrange a separate meeting or phone call. You can also ask for a conference at other times. If you're concerned about your child's progress, contact the school to make an appointment.

Some suggested questions that parents/guardians may ask their child during the Student Led Interviews may include:

- 1. How do you feel about school and your learning?
- 2. What do you like most about school and why?
- 3. Can you tell me about the work that you have chosen for your portfolio and why you chose it?
- 4. What part of your learning are you most proud of?
- 5. Can you tell me what your goals are for reading, writing and maths? How do you think you are going with these goals?
- 6. What areas of your learning would you like to improve? Why?






2023 PREP ENROLMENTS & TRANSITION PROGRAM
