Thanks to Sunshine College for the very special performance this week. Their travelling band performance was just brilliant! Such talented students at our local secondary school!






#### FELSTEAD EDUCATION- MATHS SHOW

#### SUPPORTING YOUR CHILD'S LEARNING AT HOME- (NUMERACY)

#### The Power of a Purposeful Maths Classroom Environment

A well-designed classroom environment is more than just a tidy space — it's a powerful teaching tool that directly shapes how students think, feel, and learn mathematics. The way a maths classroom is organised can either support or hinder focus, reasoning, and confidence.

A purposeful maths environment is calm, structured, and predictable. Clear routines and uncluttered spaces reduce distractions and cognitive load, allowing students to direct their mental energy toward problem-solving and understanding new concepts. Visual displays are intentional — showcasing worked examples, key vocabulary, number lines, and success criteria — rather than cluttered walls of information. These supports help students anchor their thinking and see connections between mathematical ideas.



Equally important is the emotional climate. Maths anxiety is real, and students learn best when they feel safe to take risks, explain their reasoning, and make mistakes. A positive environment is built through warm teacher-student relationships, collaborative discussion, and celebrating effort and growth, not just right answers.

When the classroom environment and teaching approach work together — through explicit instruction, visible thinking, and consistent routines — students gain the confidence and clarity they need to engage deeply in mathematical learning.

Key message: A purposeful maths classroom is calm, focused, and supportive — a space where every learner feels capable of thinking mathematically and achieving success.

## **Exploring Different Genres and Authors!**

Do you ever find yourself or your child picking up the same kinds of books again and again? Maybe you love funny stories, or books about animals, or exciting adventures. That's great — it means you know what you enjoy! But did you know there's a *whole world* of stories out there waiting to be discovered? Exploring new genres and different authors is like opening a door to a brand-new world. Each type of book — or *genre* — has something special to offer.

- Love excitement? Try an *adventure* or *mystery* story you might find yourself solving clues or exploring faraway lands.
- Enjoy make-believe? Step into *fantasy* books full of dragons, magic, and impossible worlds! Curious about the future? Try *science fiction* to imagine what life could be like on another planet or in the year 3000.
- Want to feel something real? Realistic fiction and biographies tell stories about people and emotions you might recognise from real life.
  - Love to laugh? Humorous books can brighten your day and make reading feel like playtime!

And don't forget — every author has their own unique voice. You might discover a new favourite author who tells stories in a way that feels made just for you!

Here are a few fun ways to explore new books:

- Ask your teacher or librarian for a recommendation in a genre you haven't tried.
- Try reading the first page or two sometimes it only takes a few lines to get hooked!
  - $\Omega$  Listen to an audiobook or read aloud with a friend or family member.
    - pick a book at random from the shelf you might be surprised!

When you step outside your usual reading zone, you grow as a reader — and as a thinker! You might even discover a new passion or a story that sticks with you forever.

So this week, challenge yourself: pick up a book by a *new author* or in a *new genre*. You never know what amazing adventure is waiting inside those pages.
