Reading- any reading material you have access to online or in hardcopy form. See the Epic Books app for access to over 35,000 books.

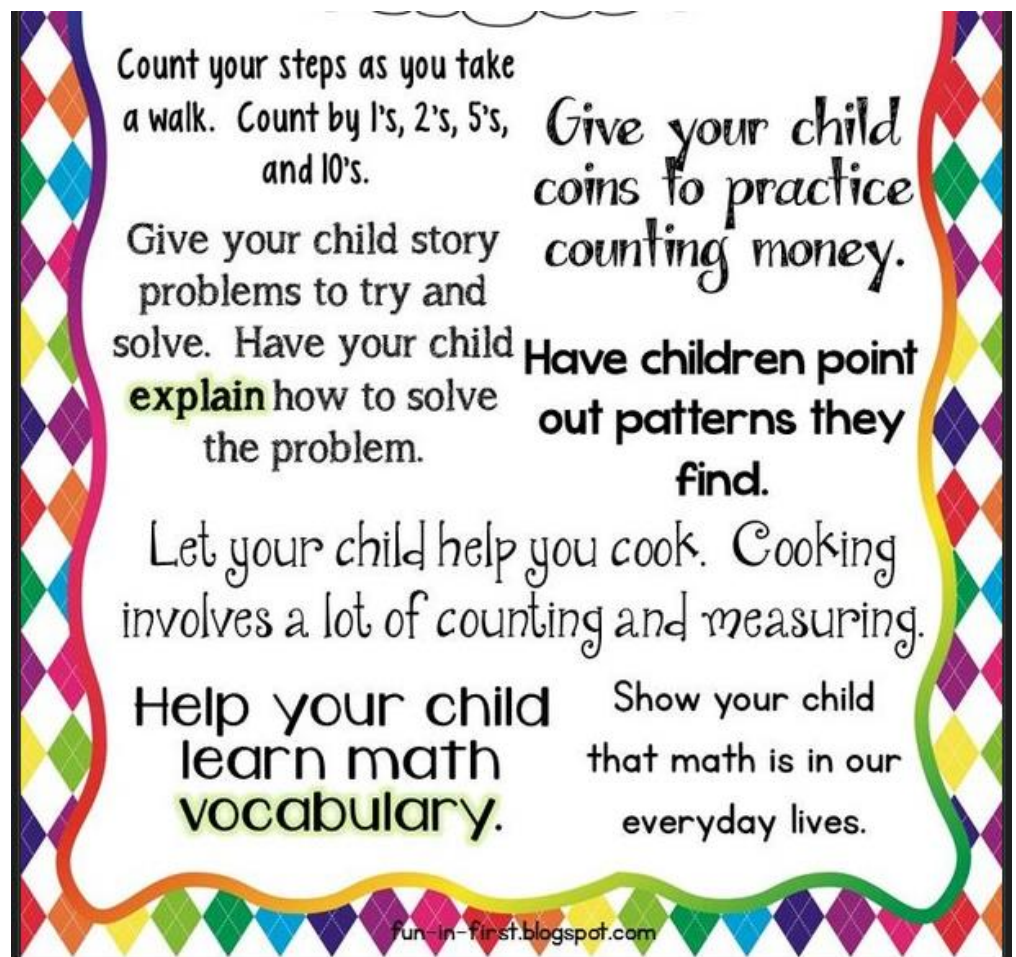
